Bookings

Re-Booking

At WetWetWet Swim School we have a re-booking loyalty system which gives our existing pupils booking priority – please see further details under heading ‘fees and payment’ and ‘discounts’. We are sadly unable to offer any of our discount schemes during Covid 19 swim timetables.

Renewals

We will send you a renewal in 2nd part of your term with us detailing your lessons for the following term – please do check your renewal as there may be a time or tutor change.

Unless we hear from you to the contrary;

We will automatically re-book you in for the same class, at the same time and at the same location. A renewal email will be sent out to you confirming these details. You will then have up until 2 weeks before the start of the renewable term to confirm by payment if you want to keep this place. If 2 weeks before the start of the term payment has not been received your booking may be cancelled and places offered to others. If you no longer want this space then please let either the receptionist at the pool or office know so the space can be released for others.

During Covid 19 timetabling, please ensure you pay by the ‘pay by date’ which will be clearly outlined in your swimming documents. If you do not pay by this date you may lose your place due to us having such limited availability.

If you would prefer a different class time then you will need to let us know you no longer want the space held for you and sort your new space ASAP.

WetWetWet Swim School reserves the right to amend dates, times, location, classes or fees at any time.

Tutors

WetWetWet Swim School reserves the right to change tutors at any point during the term. However we do try and keep the same teacher throughout the term; this cannot always be guaranteed due to unforeseen circumstances that might occur.

Cancellations

WetWetWet Swim School reserves the right to cancel classes in which the number of attendees falls below a viable level. In such cases every effort would be made to find a suitable alternative. If a suitable alternative is not found and the course has already been paid for, a credit note for the full amount you are owed will be issued and can be used for any future course booking. If there are any changes to the existing charge then the difference must be paid. Credit may be given for cancellations at the discretion of the office and under certain circumstances. In these circumstances written confirmation will be required. Refunds cannot be given prior to, during or after the classes. Credits cannot be given for children who refuse to or do not participate in their classes. Every effort is always made at the time to integrate our swimmers into their class. Credit for a long term medical issue and broken bones will require a prior written request for credit and in some situations a doctor's note.

Refunds / credits will not be offered if you are unable to attend your lesson because of extenuating circumstances, including any illnesses / weather conditions / precautionary actions or any other reason that is beyond WetWetWet Swim Schools control unless you can provide our office with a doctor's note.

If the lessons are cancelled we will endeavour to put on another session within the half-term or holidays.

PLEASE NOTE: Out of consideration for other WetWetWet Swim School customers if you wish to cancel your lessons please do so at the earliest point possible to release your reserved space for others.

Covid 19 closures; Refunds / credits will not be given if you are unable to attend your lesson due to you / someone you have been in close contact with has shown symptom's for Covid 19. We will do our utmost to fit you into a cover lesson once you are through the self-isolation period. Credits will not be given unless our lessons are cancelled / closed beyond our control. PLEASE ensure that if your children / people that you are in close contact with show any symptoms for this disease YOU DO NOT come to swimming lessons. This is your responsibility to public health and safety.

Fees and payments

Payment for WetWetWet Swim School lessons can be made in the following ways:

By card: Please call us in the office in order to make your payment by card over the phone.

By BACCS: Please send your course fees to The Co-Operative Bank.

By cheque: Fill in the form below and send it with your cheque (with your child's name and venue on the reverse), payable to WetWetWet Swim School, to the address below, or take it to the pool by the pay by date.

Child Care Vouchers; we are now able to accept child care vouchers as we are Ofsted registered. Please contact us for Child care voucher providers / account number.

PLEASE NOTE: Any unpaid cheque returned to us will incur a £6 administration fee payable to WetWetWet Swim School in addition to the normal charge for our swimming lessons. This fee is to cover the charge that we incur from the bank in this circumstance and for the necessary additional administration.

Discounts

EARLY BIRD DISCOUNTED FEES – 10% for existing pupils only when termly invoice is paid in full by the end of your first lesson of term; please do not request early bird discounts at any other time, as refusal often causes offence.

LATE FEES – Fees not paid by the 3rd week of your term will be subject to a £10 administration fee per pupil.

SIBLING DISCOUNTS – if 3 siblings attend WetWetWet Swim School, the lowest fee will be discounted to half price, the 4th class will be free when 3 classes attended and paid for in full. The lowest priced class is the free class.

YOU ARE ENTITLED TO ONE DISCOUNT i.e. you cannot use the early bird alongside sibling discount.

All classes throughout the term must be paid for, irrespective of whether or not your child attends all classes.

Covid 19 timetable: We are sadly unable to offer any of our discount schemes during Covid 19 swim timetables. We hope to be back to normal soon and to be able to once again extend our discount schemes to you.

Catch-up classes

Please note that if a class or classes are missed for reasons beyond the control of WetWetWet Swim School then the provision of a 'catch-up' class or classes is not a mandatory service but a courtesy service and goodwill gesture we try and offer to our customers. Their provision cannot be guaranteed and the following conditions apply: The same location, teacher, class size and time cannot be guaranteed. If a catch-up class is to be offered for an alternative WetWetWet Swim School class then they can only be arranged to be taken in the same term and are subject to spaces and staff being available.

Catch up classes will not be offered if you are unable to attend your lesson because of extenuating circumstances, including any illnesses / weather conditions / precautionary actions or any other reason that is beyond WetWetWet Swim Schools control.

If the lessons are cancelled by us we will endeavour to put on another session within the half-term or holidays.

Medical Information

Please advise us at the time of booking of any medical conditions we should be aware of for a swimmer. These can include: asthma, epilepsy, allergies etc

If at any time a swimmers medical condition changes, that we as a company should be aware of, you **must inform us as soon as possible**. This can be done by calling 01273 388247 or by emailing the office info@wetwetwetswimschool.co.uk. All medical information will be treated with the strictest confidence.

Coronavirus / Covid-19 / 2019-nCov; Please rest assured we as a swim school are following guidelines. Please stay updated with Coronavirus recommendations. You could stay updated by looking at websites such as [Latest guidelines for Coronavirus by Gov.uk](#). Refunds will not be given. Credits will not be given unless our lessons are cancelled / closed beyond our control. PLEASE ensure that if your children / people that you are in close contact with show any symptoms for this disease **YOU DO NOT** come to swimming lessons. This is your responsibility to public health and safety.

Our class sizes have reduced to allow for social distancing. You will not be permitted on to the pool site until your swim time slot allows. There will be one time slot of swimmers on site at any one time. Please do not be offended – this is for health and safety of all. We have added a break in between lesson times to enable touch point cleaning and sanitising of equipment.

You will need to fill in a Covid 19 'return to swimming declaration' form upon re-enrolment of swimming lessons. You will need to abide by and respect our industry's Covid 19 government guidelines. We have the right to refuse you entry to our pools if we deem it necessary.

Spectators are required to wear a face covering at all times when attending our pool venues. All who enter our building will be required to sanitise. You will be asked to sign a daily 'Covid 19 swim declaration' each time you attend our swim venues. This will need to include details of the spectator as well as the swimmer.

Swimmers will be requested to arrive at the pool 'beach ready' reducing time spent in the changing areas. Swimmers will also be asked to leave the venue in a onesie / dry robe / suitable quick change 'over garment' to reduce time spent in the changing areas and enable social distancing within the changing areas.

Asthma; Children who need access to inhalers should take them onto poolside and alert their teacher – swimmer should have the inhaler readily available for the duration of their lesson.

Gastric illness; During the course of the term, if your child suffers from any gastric illnesses please be aware that it is recommended your child does not swim for at least 5 days following. This will help provide a safe and hygienic environment for our swimmers to learn in!

Please make sure your child has at least an hour after eating before having their swimming lesson.

WetWetWet Swim School keep daily registers and will store return to swimming and daily Covid 19 declarations enabling us to track who was at our swimming pool.

At the Swimming Pools

Parents must stay in the vicinity of the swimming pool during their child's swimming lesson.

Please only park in the designated areas on the venue grounds. WetWetWet Swim School cannot accept any responsibility for cars parked in the grounds of any of the swimming pools/schools that we use.

Please ensure that your children use the changing rooms to get changed in and not poolside.

We would request that children change independently as soon as they are able. If however, your child is unable to change independently, please change them in the changing room of your own gender. (e.g.; you have a little girl and you are her father, if she needs assistance she will need to change in the 'boys' changing area)

No outdoor shoes are allowed in the venue. They must be taken off before entering the changing area. This is a health and safety requirement.

Food and drink is not permitted on any poolside.

It is necessary at any WetWetWet Swim School pool, for any person entering the water to wear a swimming hat.

Please note that all articles left on the premises at any of the pools we use are left entirely at the owner's risk. We cannot be held responsible for any lost or damaged items.

In case of emergency, and if an evacuation is necessary, please stay calm and follow the guidance of our staff.

Lost Property

All premises are checked by WetWetWet Swim School staff at the end of every swimming session and any items found are kept in lost property at the same premises (see below for exceptions)

Exception 1: Any items found deemed to be unsanitary to keep are thrown away instantly. **Exception 2:** Any items found deemed to be of large monetary value are returned to WetWetWet Swim School office. All items are kept for the duration of the term they are found in. At the end of that term, if they have not been claimed, items will either be donated to local charity shops or thrown away. To enquire if something you have lost has been found by us please either email the office info@wetwetwetswimschool.co.uk or ask the receptionist at the following weeks swimming lessons.

Our Services

All classes are limited to a maximum size of 8 swimmers. The only exception is SWIM SQUAD which is limited to 7 swimmers per lane and Adult classes which are limited to 12 swimmers. We aim to provide an assistant for all of our beginner classes. All children's swimming lessons are taught by fully qualified teachers. **All of our staff are obliged to attend regular first aid courses and our teachers are all lifesavers. All staff are DBS checked. We are fully insured.**

Our class sizes and method of teaching is slightly different during the Covid 19 pandemic. We will not be in the water with the swimmers. Our class sizes have reduced to allow for social distancing.
